In Expeditionary Learning schools, rigorous academics fuel purposeful learning beyond the classroom.




## REAL RESEARCH

Ninth-grade environmental science students at the Springfield Renaissance School in Springfield, MA conducted extensive energy audits throughout the city. Their recommendations to the Mayor garnered \$160,000 for energy-saving retrofits in the city's aging school buildings.



## REAL WORK

Kindergartners from ANSER Charter School in Boise, ID researched bird habitats, diets, and life cycles. They created bird cards with accurate scientific drawings, which were sold throughout the state to raise money for bird habitats.



## REAL CHANGE

Sixth-grade students at the Genesee Community Charter School in Rochester, NY wrote a proposal to revitalize the city's Erie Canal waterway. Their work was a key component of the Mayor's decision to commit millions of dollars to the project.




High expectations lead to achievement for all students.
